- Have knowledge in all stages of software development.
- Work alongside other developers and system/network administrators collaborating on the multiple layers of the NOAA OR&R application & network infrastructure.
- Participate in the design and overall architecture of tools & applications.
- Monitor and maintain applications & systems in-cloud and on-premises environments.
- Collaborate with the rest of the NOAA OR&R infrastructure team to design and launch new features.
